
Other producers transform local ingredients into specialty products that showcase regional flavors—Uncle Bob's




# Port Dover Beach

# Welcome to Delhi!



A bounty of fresh produce awaits you in Delhi! The town was largely built on tobacco farming in the twentieth century, but as the popularity of tobacco declines, farmers in the Delhi area have pivoted to fruits and vegetables, ginseng, hazelnuts and other plants in the tobacco family, such as hops and cannabis. The history of Delhi can be learned through the captivating exhibits at the Delhi Tobacco Museum. For instance, Delhi was once called Sovereen's Corners. after its founder, Frederick Sovereen. The culture in Delhi is shaped by the origins of the people who came to start tobacco farms in large numbers, especially in the 1950s, in the wave of post-war immigration from Europe. The nightlife still revolves around community events held at the Hungarian Hall, the German Home and the Polish club. but the party moves out to the streets for the annual Delhi Mustang Roundup, a car show







Owners Joy Algood and her sister Judith go to great lengths to source as many of their ingredients locally as possible. Joy drives to Brantford to get flours from Brant Mill. Eggs and dairy are delivered regularly from Hewitt's Dairy in Hagersville. Recognizable suppliers from Norfolk include Chambers maple syrup, Jensen's cheese, Apple Hill lavender, Fancy Farmerettes and B's honey, and Seventh Coffee, roasted in Scotland, Ontario. Fresh fruit and vegetables are sourced from the Simcoe Farmers' Market. Meadow Lynn Farms and Matz Family Fruit Barn. North Roots tea and Dalton White hazelnuts are produced in Norfolk and available for purchase at Joy Café. Even the pickles are made in house with Norfolk County cucumbers! Hot beverages are served in locally hand-made pottery cups and teapots, making your coffee break a great photo op. Support a dozen local growers in one stop at Joy Café.







# I'm No Chef, But My Grilled Asparagus Is Delicious!

Recipe by Christy Miedema

Fresh Norfolk County asparagus is so delicious and easy to cook. I don't even know what I'm doing 90% of the time I'm in the kitchen, but even I can cook delicious asparagus! When I was young, my mother always boiled our asparagus and we loved it. She was careful to boil it briefly, for only about two minutes after it turned a brighter shade of green. Overcooked asparagus is mushy and stringy at the same time, so we preferred the more consistent texture of very lightly cooked asparagus.

Later in life, I realized that grilled asparagus tastes even better! It takes on a hint of smokiness that combines nicely with the sweet chlorophyll that asparagus offers in abundance. Here's how I gleefully prep and grill fresh Norfolk County asparagus;

 Snap the bottom off each stalk by holding the very bottom with one hand and bending the bulk of

the stalk away until it snaps off. Dispose of the woody bottoms as they are too fibrous to eat.


- Submerge the asparagus in water. Cool to tepid - it doesn't seem to matter too much about the temperature. Let it soak for just a minute, and give it a swish to rinse any sand out of the tips.
- Spread the asparagus out on a paper- or dish-towel and let dry, at least mostly.

- Pour a few tablespoons of olive oil on a plate, shake some salt and pepper onto the olive oil. I sometimes use garlic salt, and seasoning salt is a tasty variation, too.
- Put a handful of spears at a time down onto the oil and roll them to coat, then transfer to another plate.
- 6. Place your spears on the pre-heated grill perpendicular to the bars to prevent losing too many spears by rolling through the slots. (To be honest, I just cook the asparagus at whatever temperature I want to cook any other foods at. It just takes a little longer if the grill is cooler)

. After the spears turn a brighter green roll them all over and wait until the leafy tips get just a bit of char starting to appear. It should only be a couple of minutes. Roll again, wait for char again, and remove

NB: Asparagus cooks quickly enough on the grill that I can do it after the meat, if I don't have enough room to cook it at the same time.

Enjoy with all your barbecued favourites and wash it down with one of our local wines or beers. Or, if my imprecise directions stress you out, get into the wine while you're still doing the prep! Norfolk County asparagus is versatile enough to be cooked a multitude of




## Rainy Days are Library Days



Scuba-divers can find a wealth of wrecks in fairly clear water around Long Point as well. People bring their horses, ATVs and snowmobiles to the St Williams Forestry Farm to make use of trails restricted to these specific forms of transport, and Gopher Dunes in Courtland is a motocross dream come true! ## Blink and You'll Miss it



When the pioneers settled Ontario, towns were very small and there were a lot of them. The evolution of transport from horse and buggy to faster cars has led to the shrinking of the villages in rural Ontario. As it became easier to get around, efficiencies of scale led

to centralizing services and industry. What tends to be left these days is a cluster of houses on a crossroads, with a sign indicating a town name and a lower speed limit. These villages were complete with churches, schools, businesses, post offices and vital railroad stations. Here are some tiny pieces of the rich history of rural hamlets.

In 1868 some ambitious Americans decided to drill for oil in Lynedoch. They built large vats to contain the oil, but never found any. What they did find was sulphur springs, which were visited by the injured and ill for the healing properties.

Dog's Nest is the hamlet that won't die. Due to its unique name, Dog's Nest's signage was stolen time and again. The businesses eventually closed, and the widening of Highway 6 led to the removal of many of its houses. Over the course of the twentieth century, Dog's Nest essentially disappeared. In 2019 however, a local man, one of the remaining population of 7, decided to raise funds for a theft-proof sign. This was achieved with a large etched rock sign in 2023.







Vittoria was briefly the capital of the London District of Upper Canada from 1815 to 1825. The courthouse (which was complete with a jail and gallows) burned down in 1825 and the government decided it made sense to seat the London District in. well. London.

Originally named Knicksville, this village adapted the shortened version of its name that was developed by railroad conductors. This easy-going community didn't deserve the tornado that, in 1907, blew the chimney off every building in the village.

Rattlesnake Harbour was so named because of early sightings of rattlesnakes here, although nowadays, herpetologists will tell you it's only a habitat for Eastern Hognose snakes, which are thankfully, non-venomous!

In 1950 an armed robbery of the Imperial Bank in Langton ended in bloodshed. Two vigilantes chased the robber from the bank. The robber shot his pursuers before hiding in the woods. 500 men participated in a manhunt that lasted three days and eventually brought the robber to justice.

Thanks to "bog iron" deposits in the marshy areas around Turkey Point, a large forge was built to produce many kinds of household goods. A pottery was also located here, making Normandale the industrial centre of the region.

You could dress up and spend a day at the races in Round Plains. It had an oval racetrack and a famous racehorse named "Alvin."

## **Birding Long Point**

Long Point is a birders' paradise. The 'Long Point Birding Area' in Norfolk County is one of Canada's premier birding locales with a wide variety of habitats including extensive public forests and wetlands to explore. If you're interested in birds or even think you might be, then a trip to LPBO is in order. For over 60 years, biologists and visitors at LPBO have studied the birds of the Long Point area. With over 400 species of birds observed, Long Point looms large as one of the most exciting places on the continent to observe our rich birdlife.

LPBO's Old Cut Research Station and Visitor Centre is open to the public during spring and fall migration (from April to mid-June, and early August to mid-November). See the birds up close during bird banding demonstrations, which run daily (weather permitting) from 9am until noon). www.birdscanada.org
